






2025 Timeline: Key Dates

- Registration: 9 June 18 July
- SHRN School Survey Pack: 5 September
- Ipsos Practice Links: 8 September
- All survey and dashboard links sent: 11/12 September
- Data Collection: 15 September 19
 December



School Registration Outline

Registration

- Registration Window: Opens 9 June and closes 18 July. Schools must register within this period to participate.
- Survey Invitation: A registration invite will be sent on 9 June to your school's key contact. If your school has a new Health and Well-being Lead, please email SHRN@cardiff.ac.uk.

Data Sharing and Consent

- Data Sharing Agreement: Schools agree to share non-identifiable aggregate data (e.g. % weekly smoker) with Public Health Wales to support school-based health improvement initiatives, such as the <u>JustB</u> prevention programme.
- Contact Consent: Consent is required to share the key contact's name and email address with your local WNHWPS coordinator and Public Health Wales to support health-related activities. (Please note: No learner-identifiable information is shared for this purpose).

Key Registration Actions to Complete by 18 July

- Appoint a Survey Lead: Identify the lead staff member who will co-ordinate the survey within your school.
- Choose a Survey Start Date: Select when your school will begin administering the survey.
- Schedule a Date for Parent/Carer Letter Distribution- this must be <u>at least</u> two weeks before learners complete the survey.

Sexual Behaviour Section Participation

Who is asked:

•Mandatory: Years 11, 12, and 13

Optional: Years 9 and 10

2023 Participation Rates:

- •65% of schools opted in for Year 9
- •86% of schools opted in for Year 10

Why it matters:

Data from this section support sexual health intervention planning and contribute to local and national population health monitoring.

Sexual Behaviour Section – Topics Covered:

- Sexual intercourse.
- Contraceptive use at last intercourse.
- Age at first intercourse.

Source: Questions derived from the internationally recognised World Health Organization's <u>Health Behaviour in School-Aged Children (HBSC) survey</u>.

Your school need to make a decision on the visibility of the sexual behaviour section at the registration stage.

Data Linkage: Changes to the 2025 Survey

•School-level consent is no longer required. With over 90% of secondary schools consenting to data linkage in 2023, SHRN has now reached an acceptable threshold of acceptability, allowing this option to be made available to all participating learners.

(Please note: there are no changes to the existing parent/carer and pupil opt-out consent process.)

- •All learners invited to:
 - Provide personal identifiers.
 - Consent to routine data linkage (e.g., via SAIL).
- **Support**: The SHRN Data Collection Pack for schools, learners, and parents and carers will provide further information. This will be sent to you on **5 September**.



Data Sharing with the SAIL Databank

- The SAIL Databank, based at Swansea University, is a secure, restricted-access repository for population data used in research.
- Cardiff University shares data under a formal agreement with Swansea University (who receives the data), and Digital Health and Care Wales (who process the data).
- The data is used only for research that benefits the public in the UK, and Cardiff University confirms it is legally allowed to share this data under UK GDPR.
- A split file process is used to protect privacy: personal details and survey responses are kept completely separate and are never stored together in the same file.
